#### **ALICE**


ALICE, a United Way acronym which stands for **Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed**, represents the growing number of individuals and families who are working, but are unable to afford the basic necessities of housing, food, child care, health care, and transportation.

• The United Way *ALICE Project* is a national initiative that provides a framework, language, and tools to measure and understand the struggles of the growing number of households in our communities that do not earn enough to afford basic necessities, a population we refer to as ALICE.
